



ONECITY TRUST MAIN GRANT FUNDING PROGRAMME OPEN FOR GRANT APPLICATIONS BETWEEN £5,000 AND £10,000

The **OneCity Trust** is pleased to announce that its main grant funding programme opens for applications from **Monday 8 March 2021**, for funding equality and social inclusion projects, whom meet **one or more** of the following priorities;

- **SOCIAL INCLUSION**
- **CULTURAL & COMMUNITY BRIDGING**
- **CIVIC INCLUSION**

For the sixth year, we are pleased to note that we continue our partnership with Travis Perkins Managed Services and the City of Edinburgh Council. This is a Community Benefit Legacy fund offered to the Council by Travis Perkins Managed Services as part of a major contract and is managed through the OneCity Trust.

Applications for this funding will be considered from organisations that involve City of Edinburgh Council tenants, **or** from other organisations aiming to benefit geographical areas with a high proportion of Council homes.



We are also delighted to announce a new partnership with CCG (Scotland) Ltd and the City of Edinburgh Council. This is a Community Benefit Legacy fund offered to the Council by CCG (Scotland) Ltd to construct 40 social rent units at Bingham and 30 at Parkview, located in the North East of the city of Edinburgh.

Applications for this funding will be considered from organisations in the North East locality area, preferably in Ward 17 – Portobello/Craigmillar where Bingham and Parkview are located.



The OneCity Trust is also delighted to be able to offer applicants the opportunity to have their grant application considered for a dedicated fund with CGI and the City of Edinburgh Council.

There is no direct financial benefit awarded to applicants, but CGI will use their technology and business consulting expertise, where they can, to deliver pro bono Information Technology (IT) work for local charities and community organisations in the City of Edinburgh.



Overall, the Trust intends to process 10 – 15 grants, of between £5,000 and £10,000 each.

The deadline for applications is **5pm, Friday 7 May 2021**, and projects should commence on **2 August 2021** and run for up to one year. Please note one off projects will also be considered.

Funding Criteria

- you must be a registered, Scottish charity or constituted community group;
- you must have been operational for at least one year;
- you must be based in Edinburgh and focussing your work in the city;
- you must supply a copy of your latest, signed annual accounts;
- you must supply evidence of a bank account in the organisations name;
- your charity's annual income, ideally should be less than £500,000 per year (but exceeding this amount may be considered), and
- you must also acknowledge the source of your funding at every opportunity, e.g. logo's on websites, promotional materials, etc.

Please note that we will not accept applications from individuals, or for the purpose of funding overseas projects, political, promotion of religion, or if you have received funding from our fund within the past year (does not apply to Rapid Action Funding).

Please note that due to the COVID19 pandemic, we are currently working remotely and are unable to accept any applications via the post.
